**Project Title:** Pronghorn habitat use and habitat selection in the Trans-Pecos region of west Texas.

**Starting Date:** 31 May 2017 (or until a suitable candidate is found)

**Description:** Student will: (1) work cooperatively with a team of graduate students, landowners, faculty, and The Nature Conservancy staff; (2) be responsible for gathering geospatial, demographic, and other attribute data in a GIS, and perform analysis relative to pronghorn movement; (3) conduct vegetative, dietary, and nutritional analyses; (4) participate in report writing; and (5) assist with other research activities. **Qualifications:** B.S. in wildlife ecology or closely related discipline with superior academic record and competitive GRE scores. Student must (1) exhibit competencies in GIS, GPS, remote sensing, and radiotelemetry; and (2) possess a strong work ethic and excellent communication skills. Applicants with plant identification experience are strongly encouraged to apply.

**Assistantship:** Assistantship with benefits including health insurance (~\$15,000/yr) and out-of-state tuition waived.
